- Habitability Standards & Maintenance | Apr. 18, 2013 | 9:00 am – 4:00 pm | Tony Drost, MPM® RMP®**
 Course materials will cover specific information from the Uniform Housing Code concerning basic habitability standards that govern local codes, policies of insurance companies, and our own Standards of Professionalism. 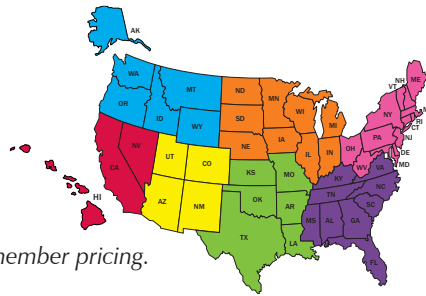
