## DESIGNATIONS

### Master Property Manager (MPM®)

To earn your MPM® designation, a total of **200 ELECTIVE POINTS** are required in addition to your main requirements for candidacy. Please use this link for more information on this designation. <http://www.narpm.org/education/designations/MPM.htm>

### Residential Management Professional (RMP®)

To earn your RMP® designation, a total of **50 ELECTIVE POINTS** are required in addition to your main requirements for candidacy. Please use this link for more information on this designation. <http://www.narpm.org/education/designations/RMP.htm>

### Certified Support Specialist (CSS®)

To earn your CSS® designation, a total of **25 ELECTIVE POINTS** are required in addition to your main requirements for candidacy. Please use this link for more information on this designation. <http://www.narpm.org/education/designations/CSS.htm>

### Certified Residential Management Company (CRMC®)

This esteemed designation is awarded to those professional property management firms that demonstrate a high standard in both procedures and customer service. ## HERE ARE JUST A FEW WAYS YOU CAN EARN ELECTIVE POINTS

Please see the candidacy checklist that corresponds to each designation for a more comprehensive list.

### 30 Points

Serve as one of the principal individuals responsible for a Chapter or Chapter in formation or serve as an officer (i.e. President, Vice-President, Secretary or Treasurer) for your local or state NARPM® Chapter.

### 25 Points

Serve as a National Committee Chair for NARPM®.

### 25 Points

Minimum of 30 hours in property management education within previous 36 month period. (Does not include the NARPM® Designation classes or conference workshop sessions.)

### 25 Points

Serve as Conference Chair for your State/Regional Broker/Owner NARPM® Conference.

### 15 Points

Serve as a committee chair (i.e. Membership Chair, Publications/Program Chair, Education Chair, etc.) for your local or state NARPM® Chapter.

### 15 Points

Serve as a Committee Chair for your State Chapter.

### 15 Points

Significant contribution through non-NARPM® property management forum, confirmed in writing by committee chair or supervising party.

### 15 Points

Write an original article for the NARPM® Residential Resource Magazine. Articles must be approximately 700 words and be of educational benefit to the membership. (Your article must be accepted for publication in order to receive points.)

### 10 Points

Attend a NARPM® national leadership conference.

### 10 Points

Attend our National Convention (not including the requirement for designation).

### 10 Points

Serve as an active National NARPM® Committee member, confirmed in writing by a National Committee Chair.

### 5 Points

Attend our Broker/Owner Retreat or a State/Regional Conference (with a maximum of 2 years).

### 5 Points

Attend a NARPM® State/Regional Leadership Development Training.

### 5 Points

Serve as a local/state Chapter committee member.

### 1-30 Points

Service project for NARPM®, assigned by the Board of Directors or a National Committee Chair and approved by the Professional Development Chair.
